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### MORE REPORTING, LOWER COSTS


Using the data portal, a single journalist can quickly determine what is happening in each neighborhood. The data dramatically increases reporting capacity while adding minimal costs.




City of Los Angeles March 1-31th, 2019 vs 2020





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

The high cost of housing is at the root of so many of our local issues, from homelessness to the general lack of afforability which is [chasing people out of the region] (https://laist.com/news/40-percent-of-california-residents-said-theyreconsidering-leaving-the-state-most-say-theyre-being-priced-out).

Crosstown recently reported on the slow pace of construction for new buildings and the flat number of demolitions taking place—both are flashing red lights about the city's capacity to add to its housing stock in the near future.

But there is one bright spot, and it's this:

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That's the number of **\*\*accesory dwelling units\*\*** permitted during the past 12 months (May 1, 2023–April 30, 2024). Better known as ADUs, these are the <u>[usually modest apartments](https://xtown.la/2022/09/20/adus–los–angeles– housing–numbers/)</u> in a reconfigured garage or that rise in the corner of a backyard.

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





### WE WANT TO MAKE THE CROSSTOWN APPROACH AVAILABLE TO OTHER NEWSROOMS.

We can build a Crosstown system for newsrooms just about anywhere. The system runs with minimal maintenance costs.





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With a reasonable upfront investment, we can deploy Crosstown's software, mapping and data-sorting tools in newsrooms across the country. Newsroom can use this to track the vital signs of its coverage area, along with every neighborhood in it. We know that if more journalists had the same easy access to data to cover their cities and towns, they would break new ground and expand their reporting.
